What is peer mentoring?

Peer mentoring is a relationship of trust and support between two people who share similar life experiences.

Your mentor will be someone who has already managed to integrate into Greek society and wants to help you do the same by sharing knowledge, experiences, and practical advice, especially on issues related to housing, employment, and financial management.

How can a mentor help you?

Your mentor can help you:

- Understand how key public services work (healthcare, education, social support)
- Get guidance on employment, housing, and financial management matters
- Set personal goals and plan the steps needed to achieve them
- Build confidence and a sense of belonging in your new community

Above all, you will have someone who listens to you, understands you, and encourages you throughout your journey.

Who can participate?

We are looking for individuals who:

- Have been living in Greece for at least one year with a valid residence permit
- Want to improve their daily life and become more actively involved in society
- Are open to learning and willing to receive guidance
- Can commit to a 12-month programme with regular meetings with their mentor



Programme timeline & participant commitments



Call for Applications & Selection:

1 month (you can submit your application until **21 November 2025**)



Peer Mentoring Period:

10 months of individual mentoring per pair
Meetings (lasting 1.5–2 hours) can take place either in person or online.

Weekly meetings are recommended at the beginning of the programme, with flexibility in frequency as it progresses.
